CC4CA applauds Governor Hickenlooper’s climate announcement

Colorado Communities for Climate Action released today the following statement by Anita Seitz, CC4CA president and a member of the Westminster City Council, on behalf of the coalition:

“We enthusiastically applaud Governor Hickenlooper’s goals of reducing statewide heat-trapping emissions by at least 26 percent by 2025, compared to 2005 levels, and his commitment to partner with local governments to get there. This would have Colorado do our share to fulfill the national commitment the United States made under the Paris Agreement.

“As the governor said, his announcement today “is a beginning,” and as local government leaders from across Colorado, we look forward to working with him to bring about the actions that will be needed to meet these goals and protect Colorado’s climate for this and future generations.”
